Profile Kertajati Airport

West Java International Airport (BIJB) located in District Kertajati, Majalengka is approximately 68 km from the city of Bandung, the capital of West Java province. Strategically placed around the growing area of West Java, accessibility Kertajati service is guaranteed by the highway and railway connecting Bandung, Kertajati, and Cirebon, and toll road Cileunyi - Sumedang - Dawuan (Cisumdawu) to connect Bandung and Kertajati; Cikopo toll road - palimanan (Cipali) connecting Kertajati Industrial Estate Majalengka (KIEM); and also a direct link to the port of Cirebon.

Kertajati overall service is built on an area of 1,800 ha and its construction is divided into three stages. Currently new development completed ditahap terminal 1A with an area of 96 200 square meters. As for the ultimate airport terminal brings the concept of peacocks have reached 209 500 sq m.

Since it was established last May by President Joko Widodo (Jokowi), and officially put into operation in June 2018, now Kertajati new service has one runway or runway 2,500 meters. This runway will increase to 3,500 meters in order to accommodate wide-body aircraft such as the Airbus A380-800. Ditahap end of this airport will have two runways.

With such capacity could Kertajati Airport serves 5.6 million passengers per year and will be able to accommodate 18 million passenger traffic in the next year. Seeing the growing needs of the community interested in the air-based transportation, the airport with an investment of Rp 2.6 Trillion This certainly could guarantee meeting the needs of air travel in the future.

Airport owner's three-letter code KJT, beginning this operation is targeted to open 14 domestic and international routes. Including pilgrimage flight service could be felt from the airport pride of West Java at the end of this year. The high mobility of people will automatically take the movement of goods. This service also provides cargo at the beginning of the operation in which the initial operation of the 0,004 million tons of one could be served. While the overall cargo in BIJB will be expanded to reach 1.5 million tons by the year 2045.





ELECTRICITY

Electricity is an important infrastructure in supporting economic growth, encouraging investment, and industrial equity, which has a further impact on the creation of employment and regional economies.

The stability of electricity supply is the key to the growth of the modern industry which will spur improvement in the national economy.

With this fact, Kertajati Industrial Estate Majalengka (KIEM) and PLN agreed to build a 150 kV substation at Kertajati - Majalengka. The KIEM field substation in the area of almost 20,000 square meters is the first project in the area to be built in the industrial area and it is ensured that customers in the KIEM industrial area become premium customers, with guarantees without power outage electricity, customers will receive compensation from PLN.

KIEM has been a pioneer in the construction of electric substations in industrial estates in Kertajati close to the electricity load center in industrial estates. So it is very strategic and effective in serving customer needs. In addition to supplying industrial areas, the presence of 200 MVA substations will later strengthen the Java-Bali electricity system by adding the electric power capacity sent.
